1. Chase Field, home of the Arizona Diamondbacks, is one of the few baseball stadiums in the world to feature a retractable roof, air conditioning and a natural-grass playing surface. It also boasts Major League Baseball's biggest video board and a swimming pool.
2. The Heard Museum in Phoenix, AZ.
3. Phoenix Night Skyline - Phoenix in the Spring. Shot from South Mountain. Phoenix is the urban heart of Arizona and the fifth-largest city in the United States. Its downtown core is located just minutes away from mountain parks, resorts, golf courses and one of the nation's 10 busiest airports.
